#### **Biggin Hill Romania Group Christmas Appeal 2020**

It is around this time of year that the charity is usually busy collecting and sorting donations for the Christmas shoe box appeal. St Mary's has brought happiness to many children and their families over the years. This year, like many things, everything is different. Apart from Covid 19 the BHRG is currently unable to send shoe and family boxes to Romania due to the high cost of transportation. So, how can we all still help the very special children and their families who live in and around Comanesti?

The intention is to help the local economy as well as up to 100 families by raising funds to buy food, cleaning supplies and gifts locally. The purchase and delivery of provisions will be coordinated by the local representative of the charity who has lived and worked in Comanesti from the beginning in conjunction with the mayor's office. It is hard to imagine the level of need and poverty that many families still endure, or their relief and joy when they receive the gifts.
