While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. He said to them, "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. Junior Church Leader

Due to a change in personal circumstances, the role of Junior Church Leader (JCL) will become vacant from September 2021.

The role of JCL involves working alongside the Incumbent, planning and implementing agreed Sunday groups and activities for young people, along with other potential young person meetings and services at agreed times. Experience in church life with a particular focus on young people is essential, as is having a vision for and overview of the ministry of Junior Church. The JCL must also have the desire to serve alongside existing church groups to ensure that our young people experience the full range of experiences that are on offer through St. Mary's.

The role of JCL provides an opportunity to develop and work with young people from within our church and wider community, for their faith to flourish or to allow young people to learn to know what it is to be church and to be people of faith.
